## Introduction

When students begin thinking about their college application essay, many instinctively ask, “What do colleges want to hear?” That question often leads students away from their most powerful stories. The most compelling college essays aren’t written to impress — they’re written to express.

## Write From What Inspires You — Not What You Think Sounds Good

Choose a topic rooted in genuine curiosity and passion. Ask what inspires you, what you care about, and what ideas stay with you. When you write from something meaningful, your voice becomes natural and engaging.

## Help the Reader Picture You

Your essay should help an admissions reader imagine you in the classroom and on campus. Consider the attitude, energy, and perspective you would bring to a college community.

## Focus on WHO You Are, Not WHAT You’ve Done

Your activities list shows what you’ve done. Your essay should reveal who you are — your values, mindset, and how you make meaning from experiences.

## Start Small, Then Pull Back

Beginning with a close-up moment draws the reader in. From there, pull back to connect that moment to broader ideas about your identity, growth, and aspirations.

## Pay Attention to Where You Spend Your Time

Look at your playlists, reading habits, and how you spend free time. These details often reveal your curiosity, interests, and inner world.

## Use Sensory Detail to Bring the Story to Life

Be descriptive. Let the reader see, hear, and feel the moment. Sensory detail makes your story vivid and memorable.

## Be the Hero of Your Own Story — With Reflection

If writing about a challenge, focus on growth and insight. Colleges care about how you worked through experiences and what you learned.

## Know Your Audience

Admissions officers value intellectual curiosity and reflection. Make clear how you think, what excites you about learning, and how you engage with ideas.

## Final Thought: Let the Essay Sound Like You

A meaningful essay sounds authentic. When you choose a topic rooted in who you are, your essay becomes an invitation for a college to imagine you as part of its community.
